## Stuff I've done:

- Came with intermittent starting issue. Replaced starter relay. Then found out solenoid was also intermittent on re-built bosch starter. Installed new EME starter.
- Installed KATDASH GS & led gauge lights
- Speedometer serviced and odo button rubber replaced by Terry Vrla
- Had rear drive serviced & new paralever pivot bushings installed by Tom Cutter
- Spline lube winter 2018
- New air filter & clutch dust cover (at starter) installed. (it was missing)
- Install oem shift lever. (roller bearing shift it came with included)
- Oem yellow bumblebee bench seat (so 3 seats come with bike- I needed a yellow bumble bee seat and solo seat is too short for me.)
- New fuse box (old one had broken mount.)
- Led running lights
- Clean & detail the entire bike- it was pretty grungy & much of the aluminum had never been cleaned. Aluminum all maintained with boeshield T-9 now.
- New gas lines, replace carb manifold tubes with stiffer (as recommended by cutter)
- Custom R100GS yellow engine badges
- New yellow plug wires
- Restored carbs to stock jets. Replaced cork bowl gaskets & float needles. Tuned with Harmonizer
- Added a BMW tool kit/roll (bike did not come with one)
- Patch/spot painting bare/rusty spots on front frame
- Installed missing clutch switch at handlebar
- New Conti Trail Attack 2 tires (20/80) May 2019. About 600 miles on them.
- Regular maintenance/ oil changes etc
